

**August 4, 2009 Election  
Dickson Township  
Ballot Propositions**

PROPOSITION I:

**Fire Department Operation and Maintenance Renewal Millage.**

Shall Dickson Township, Manistee County, Michigan, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in Dickson Township, Manistee County, Michigan, by an additional one and one-half (1.5) mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional one and one-half (1.5) mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years (2009 through 2013, inclusive) for the purpose of providing additional funds for the Fire Department operations and maintenance expenses? (This is a renewal of the one and one-half (1.5) mills for Fire Department operation and maintenance expenses for five (5) years which expired in 2008; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$56,592.)

PROPOSITION II:

**Fire Department Operating, Capital Improvement and Equipment Acquisition Renewal Millage.**

Shall Dickson Township, Manistee County, Michigan, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in Dickson Township, Manistee County, Michigan, by an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years (2009 through 2013, inclusive) for the purpose of fire department operating, capital improvement and capital acquisition purposes, including the purchase of fire fighting and emergency response equipment? (This is a renewal of the two (2) mills for Fire Department operating, capital improvement and fire fighting and emergency response equipment acquisition purposes for five (5) years which expired in 2008; if approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be \$75,456.)
