

Recycle! How to recycle at Manistee County PA69 Recycling Drop-Off locations

RECYCLE PAPER in the semi-trailer or green paper dumpster.



Paper

YES - RECYCLE THESE!

- Copy, writing, computer paper
- Unwanted mail, newspapers, magazines and catalogs
- Telephone books
- Brown paper bags
- Cardboard boxes
- Paperboard boxes (shoe, cereal and food, tissue boxes)

PREPARATION

- Remove paper from plastic bags
- Remove paper clips, strapping and plastic "windows" from boxes

NOT RECYCLABLE

- Wrapping or tissue paper
- Disposable paper (napkins, tissue, paper towel, wax paper, plates, etc.)
- Paper with food or food stains
- Wax coated or frozen food boxes



Glass

YES - RECYCLE THESE!

- Clean glass bottles and jars

PREPARATION

- Rinse all containers
- Remove and recycle lids

NOT RECYCLABLE

- Dishware or ceramics
- Light bulbs, fluorescent tubes
- Broken windows, mirrors



Metal

YES - RECYCLE THESE!

- Steel and tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil and cans

PREPARATION

- Rinse clean

NOT RECYCLABLE

- Pots, pans, bakeware and utensils
- Hangers
- Car parts or scrap metal
- Paint cans
- Propane cylinders
- Foil backed paper
- Siding, window frames and doors



Plastic

YES - RECYCLE THESE!

- Plastic food, home and beauty product containers with these symbols:



- Plastic grocery and retail bags marked with the #2 or #4 symbol.

PREPARATION

- Empty and rinse all containers
- Flatten jugs (lids can stay on)
- Plastic bags must be empty, clean and dry.

NOT RECYCLABLE

- Plastic containers that held automotive fluids or hazardous materials
- Foam cups, plates, peanuts, packaging, etc.
- Plastic film (food wrap, stretch wrap)

Where and When to Recycle?

Recycling is available to residents of PA69 participating Townships 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at these locations:

- Arcadia Township Hall 3422 Lake Street/Arcadia
- Betsie Valley School 17936 Cadillac Highway/Thompsonville
- Brown Township Hall 8233 Coates Highway/Manistee
- 14420 Walta Street at Osmo Street/Kaleva
- Onekama Township Hall 5435 Main Street/Onekama

Use of these recycling drop-off locations is exclusive to residents of PA69 participating Townships only.

What is the PA69 Recycling Program?

Public Act 69 allows Michigan Counties, Townships and municipalities to enter into an agreement to fund a residential recycling program. Participation in the Manistee County PA69 Recycling Program provides an easy to use, convenient and cost effective drop-off program, public education, and minimal Township administration.

PA69 Townships include:

Arcadia Township, Brown Township, Cleon Township/Village of Copemish, Maple Grove Township/Village of Kaleva, Marilla Township, Onekama Township/Village of Onekama, Springdale Township

Why Recycle?

- Putting recyclables in the trash is a WASTE of usable resources.
- The paper recycling program provides funding for our local school programs.
- Recycling means business! You help sustain Michigan's recycling industry while protecting Michigan jobs.
- It's the right thing to do out of respect for our community, our natural environment and future generations.

Recycling Tips:

- Recyclables are collected in 2 separate categories. Recycle glass, metals and plastics in the large green recycling container with openings on the sides. Recycle paper and cardboard in either the semi-trailer or the green paper recycling dumpster.
- To make it quick and easy at the drop-off, use a paper bag at home to collect paper products. Use a plastic storage bin and reuse it to collect and transport plastics, glass and metals.
- Keep items clean by rinsing containers before recycling them.
