<b>Paper</b>	<p><b>YES - RECYCLE THESE!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Copy, writing, computer paper</li> <li>- Mail, newspapers, magazines</li> <li>- Telephone books</li> <li>- Brown paper bags</li> <li>- Cardboard/ Paperboard boxes</li> </ul> <p><b>PREPARATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Flatten boxes</li> <li>- Remove paper from plastic bags</li> <li>- Remove paper clips, strapping &amp; plastic "windows" from boxes</li> </ul>	<p><b>NOT RECYCLABLE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Wrapping or tissue paper</li> <li>- Disposable paper (napkins, tissue, paper towel, wax paper, plates, etc.)</li> <li>- Paper with food or food stains</li> <li>- Wax coated or frozen food boxes</li> <li>- Pizza boxes</li> <li>- Furnace filters</li> </ul>
	<p><b>YES - RECYCLE THESE!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Food, home and beauty product containers # 1,2,3,4,5,6,7</li> <li>- Plastic grocery and retail bags with the #2 or #4 symbol.</li> </ul> <p><b>PREPARATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Empty and rinse all containers</li> <li>- Flatten jugs (lids can stay on)</li> <li>- Clean and dry plastic bags only.</li> </ul>	<p><b>NOT RECYCLABLE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Plastic containers that held automotive fluids or hazardous materials</li> <li>- Foam cups, plates, peanuts, packaging, etc.</li> <li>- Plastic film (food / stretch wrap)</li> <li>- Trash Bags</li> <li>- Pet food, feed or seed bags</li> </ul>
<b>Plastic</b>	<p><b>YES - RECYCLE THESE!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Steel and tin cans</li> <li>- Empty aerosol cans</li> <li>- Aluminum foil and cans</li> </ul> <p><b>PREPARATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Rinse clean</li> </ul>	<p><b>NOT RECYCLABLE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pots, pans, bakeware and utensils</li> <li>- Hangers</li> <li>- Car parts or scrap metal</li> <li>- Paint cans</li> <li>- Propane cylinders</li> <li>- Foil backed paper</li> <li>- Siding, window frames and doors</li> </ul>
	<p><b>YES - RECYCLE THESE!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Clean glass bottles and jars</li> </ul> <p><b>PREPARATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Rinse all containers</li> <li>- Remove and recycle lids</li> </ul>	<p><b>NOT RECYCLABLE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dishware or ceramics</li> <li>- Light bulbs, fluorescent tubes</li> <li>- Broken windows, mirrors</li> <li>- Window or door glass</li> <li>- Broken glass</li> </ul>

**Recycle Right to Keep Recycling**

This is YOUR recycling program, supported with public funding. Recycling Right keeps costs in check and the program available.

Keep Recycling Right by remembering to:

- Only recycle YES items
- Flatten ALL boxes and plastic jugs
- NO FOAM PRODUCTS (even if it's marked with a recycling logo)

**Non-Recyclable Plastic Home Goods**

The following plastic home goods items are not recyclable as part of the Manistee County PA69 program.

- Toys
- Coolers
- Lawn Furniture
- Garden Hose
- Siding
- Plastic Shelves
- Laundry Baskets
- Plastic Tables
- Plastic Boxes

**Where and When to Recycle?**

Recycling is available to residents of PA69 participating Townships 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at these locations:

- Arcadia Township Hall 3422 Lake Street/Arcadia
- Betsie Valley School 17936 Cadillac Highway/Thompsonville
- Brown Township Hall 8233 Coates Highway/Manistee
- 14420 Walta Street at Osmo Street/Kaleva
- Onekama Township Hall 5435 Main Street/Onekama

Use of these recycling drop-off locations is exclusive to residents of PA69 participating Townships only.

**What is the PA69 Recycling Program?**

Public Act 69 allows Michigan Counties, Townships and municipalities to enter into an agreement to fund a residential recycling program. Participation in the Manistee County PA69 Recycling Program provides an easy to use, convenient and cost effective drop-off program, public education, and minimal Township administration.

Arcadia Township, Brown Township, Cleon Township/Village of Copemish, Maple Grove Township/Village of Kaleva, Marilla Township, Onekama Township/Village of Onekama, Springdale Township
