REVIEW OF EVALUATION FORM COMMENTS FROM 12TH REGIONAL SUMMIT

DISCUSSION REGARDING EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION LUNCHEON

The Employee Recognition Luncheon will be on December 15, 2015 after the County Board meeting. Funds of \$700 have been budgeted for the Luncheon. Karen Goodman suggested changing from a pizza luncheon to a catered light lunch, with Zupin Catering preparing the food.

There was discussion of inviting the News Advocate to the Luncheon to highlight those employees with long term careers with the County.

Lunch break will need to be extended on December 15th by half an hour for the Luncheon.

Moved by Shafer, seconded by Goodman to recommend \$800 be used to cover the cost of the Employee Recognition Luncheon and to provide the employees with an additional half hour lunch.


NEXT MEETING DATE

The next meeting has been scheduled for December 4, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.


OTHER ITEMS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS
