MINUTES

SHERIFF'S OFFICE

Undersheriff Torrey presented the monthly statistics for December 2025. The stats for the Bailiffs appear normal with 3300-3500 people coming into the courthouse. There appears to be a significant number of knives (pocket knives) being collected at the scanner/door. There are three on-staff employees currently in training. That training will last approximately four months.

Sheriff Gutowski reported that the department has ordered a drone that was paid for with internal funds. The department will have the capability to deploy the equipment immediately from having it in the vehicle at all times and instead of waiting for assistance from mutual aid. Previously, the department had signed an agreement with

CPC as the phone provider for the jail. That agreement came with a \$15,000 technology grant each year. The FCC has implemented a ruling with phone systems within jails. There is now a rate cap on facility cost recovery for audio and video in correctional facilities. That creates a drastic reduction from approximately \$1,050/month on phone commissions to now collecting \$300/month, and it eliminates the ability for technology grants. The department is partnering with the Chamber of Commerce and hosting an Active Shooter Training course that the community can sign up for. Staffing is needed in the jail as they are down two employees. It has been a rough winter with fatal crashes. The Sheriff will bring the Year-In-Review statistics to the March Board of Commissioners Meeting. The department will be hosting the Chamber Leadership Meeting again this year. The staff always enjoys working with these individuals. The K9 is being trained. They look forward to getting the unit up and running.

Lt. Chris Banicki reported the jail statistics for the month of December 2025. There were 30 bookings into the jail. There are some issues with the reporting that they are working through. One employee is retiring in May, and the jail is down two staff members currently. There were 93 mattresses replaced and paid for out of internal funds. The livescan fingerprint machine is in the process of being replaced. That machine will be paid for by internal funds. There are several training courses coming up in March.

### **CITY OF MANISTEE**

**Fire:** City Fire Chief Tom Herndon reported that the fire station has been placed on the National Register of Historical Places. The year-end numbers reflect 1,270 incidents were recorded in 2025. Of those calls, 27 were actual fire calls, 80% are EMS calls which are higher than the national average. The newer firefighters have reached the 6-month mark and are about half-way through paramedic school. They are doing very well. Onkama Fire Chief Rob Johnson and Chief Herndon have been working on creating a Fire District. The Filer Township, Onkama Township, and Manistee Township Boards have signed letters of intent to form the Fire District. Each of those entities has dedicated \$5,000 toward this District to fund attorney fees and such. Stronach Township will be holding their Board meeting this upcoming week. The current schedule is to hold bi-weekly meetings and develop Articles of Incorporation for the District.

### **911/EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

Alvin Rischel, Emergency Manager, reported that the statistics for the 911/Central Dispatch are provided in the packet. In the future, the stats will be provided bi-monthly. The department is preparing for a March 11 LEIN Audit.

There are some trainings coming up soon. The National Active Assailant Conference in June, and the National Homeland Security Conference in May. Region 7, Lt. Michael de Castro has announced his retirement date of September 30.

**MMR (MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE)**

Dan Mosholder, Operations Manager Manistee/Wexford, reviewed the statistics and the 3-year trend. As a reminder to the public, this time of year, there is a delay with transfers and inclement weather. The supervisor position in Manistee remains open. There are two employees that remain in paramedic class. They are about halfway through. The department shift schedule is currently being worked on. There is room to add two full-time EMT positions, and they are currently short-staffed for three full-time paramedic positions. One will return in March that is on maternity leave. MMR is planning for Fiscal Year 2027/2028 to build a station in the northern part of the county. They are looking for property at this time.

**STATE POLICE**

Lt. Travis House reported the statistics for 2025. There were 7,381 traffic stops over the past year, which averages 615 per month. Of those, 50 were OWI arrests, and 2,805 were issued citations. There were 4,231 incidents, which were items that they went to. The department had responded to 2,253 dispatched calls. Criminal incident closure rates will be reported in another month or two for more accurate numbers. The department is potentially looking at placing a trooper on the TNT task force. (Traverse Narcotic Team). Staffing with the Post includes a few retirements in the near future. One or two cadet positions will become available.

The meeting was adjourned at the Call of the Chair at 11:58 a.m.




