**MINUTES**

Travis House, State Police; Lisa Sagala, County Controller/Administrator; and Debra Nalley, Deputy Clerk.

The meeting was called to Order at 2:00 p.m.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

None.

**SHERIFF'S OFFICE ITEMS**

Sheriff Gutowski presented the statistics for the month of August 2022. (APPENDIX A) The Courthouse Bailiffs stopped 39 knives. No guns were found. CRAZE training continues. They currently attended an Active Shooter exercise in Mason County on August 25, 2022. Dive training recently took place at Canfield Lake. The department previously obtained an Aqua Eye sonar device. After the recent event on Bear Lake the department obtained hummingbird graphs for all boats. The dive team is funded through donations from PCA and Revenue Sharing.

There was a huge shortfall in Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), which helps fund the Children's Advocacy Center. DHHS made changes in how they are distributing those

funds, cutting available funds in half. The request for VOCA this year was \$208,000, they were only going to fund at \$50,000. The State wants a VOCA agreement thru CAC signed for the \$50,000 level and are promising a supplemental funding package to bring funding up. There is a hesitation in signing \$50,000 agreement and not receiving supplemental funding but if agreement not signed, CAC does not receive \$50,000 funding. Sheriff Gutowski would like to see a letter of support from Board.

### **CITY OF MANISTEE PUBLIC SAFETY ITEMS**

Chief Glass recently went with the Coast Guard to observe their duties and capabilities. The City Police Department is fully staffed at 13 officers. There are now 5-6 liaisons assigned to the Manistee Area Public schools and new safety equipment has been installed along with a truancy plan that has been implemented. Upcoming events will be covered by City Police, Labor fest, Hops and Props. He said there has been feedback on the new pedestrian signs downtown on River Street, Margaret Batzer would like something more done about cars going down River Street the wrong way. Chief Glass will have the department look into that.

Chief Cameron, the City Fire Department said call volume was at 964 for the month of August 2022. Stated only one employee left to be certified and then all eight employees will be certified paramedics.

### **MICHIGAN STATE POLICE REPORT**

Lt. Travis House stated their post will be changing from the Oaks Correctional Facility to the Community Center in Kaleva and potentially opening a post in Traverse City. The FMLA benefit giving new fathers 12 weeks off paid leave has been implemented for employees. The district reported reduced crashes. MSP will be covering the upcoming Ironman event in Frankfort on September 11, 2022. This year's route changed to alleviate traffic.

### **TRIBAL POLICE ITEMS**

### **MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE (MMR)**

Amy Fairchild presented statistics for MMR. (APPENDIX B) There were 172 calls for EMS services and 25 transfers. They have less staffing, but another academy is in near future. They need to hire 4 to 5 individuals. She stated a flex car out of Manistee is available, and two trucks 24 hours a day, possibly three trucks in near future.

**JAIL ADMINISTRATOR ITEMS**

Lt. Chris Banicki presented the August 2022 jail statistics. (APPENDIX C) The jail is averaging 26 inmates daily, 51 arrests, are responsible for 30 inmates. On October 3, 2022 Bryan Jensen will attend the corrections academy at West Shore Community College. The jail has purchased stun cuffs for \$3,600 which will help the court staff. Problems continue for inpatient facilities for inmates with mental health matters.
