The meeting was called to Order at 2:00 p.m.

The County Board and its Committees are operating remotely and electronically by Zoom under the Manistee County Board of Commissioners Resolution #2020-17, which declared a Local State of Emergency through December 31, 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

PUBLIC COMMENT

SHERIFF'S OFFICE ITEMS

Undersheriff Jason Torrey reviewed the Sheriff's Statistics Report (Appendix A) for August 2021.

Sheriff Brian Gutowski reported they are still hiring three (3) Corrections Officers (CO) and just accepted another resignation from another CO. A new Deputy was pinned at college graduation, and he will be starting with the County soon. Sheriff Gutowski reported that he and Lisa Sagala met with Enterprise representatives regarding fleet services. They are exploring options of using Enterprise for the police fleet. Newago County has been using Enterprise for 3-4 years so they will be looking at their cost savings and fleet equity. Pros and cons are currently being reviewed.

The Jail Administrator is working with MI Works for a GED teacher to help those released from jail to transition from jail to home and continuing their schooling for a GED. They may be partnering with Benzie County as well. Possibly 3 days/4 hours per day=12 hours per week at a cost of \$13,000, which would be paid from the Jail revenue.

The School Resource Officer started in the schools the beginning of the school year. Also, cooperative training will be done with the Coast Guard in the fall/winter. The Sheriff reported that traffic complaints are higher than ever and overall, there are 2611 total complaints so far.

CITY OF MANISTEE PUBLIC SAFETY ITEMS

Chief Glass reported that now that school is in session, there are additional responsibilities as Officers are assigned as school liaisons to each school in the City. Hiring for a 13th Officer will be happening. Robust training has been taking place and will continue into the fall. It is reported that there is a large uptick in violent crimes.

MICHIGAN STATE POLICE REPORT

Trooper Skorka reported there were 89 complaints in August. Two (2) new Troopers with one more soon are being hired. Other events that the State Police are involved in are the Labor Day Bridge Walk and the Ironman Triathlon.

LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS REPORT

MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE (MMR)

Paul Owens of MMR, reported that with the staffing shortfall, MMR is taking an aggressive approach. MMR also has a new reporting program called Tramasoft. There were 186 calls in August 2021, some of which had to have law enforcement called to secure the area. There were two part time paramedics and one full time EMT hired.

As mentioned, MMR has implemented a tiered approach to their service areas that have the greatest need for staffing. There are eleven initiatives from increased sign on bonus',

extra stipend pay for every 12 hours of shift work, new stipends for picking up additional shifts, extra pay for every four years of service and retention bonus'. MMR has also eliminated the non-compete clause. MMR has obtained a list of all 12,000 licensed EMT's in the State of Michigan and have sent letters informing them of the initiatives. They have launched a PR campaign and have partnered with Munson Hospitals for EMT and paramedic program. Employees at Munson can now subcontract to work at MMR with current rate of pay, and overtime pay. They also have tuition deferred sponsorship, paid at 100% tuition with a two year commitment. MMR is sending resources to NW Michigan from other areas including Grayling. Insurance is available on day one if the new employee needs it. Jason Sopha thanked Mr. Owens for his help, hard work and leadership in filling positions and moving forward. A third truck will be available three of seven days of the week as a result of the initiatives. The ownership and financial help of Munson is making these initiatives possible. Paid training through a grant has been applied for as well. These initiatives show that MMR is investing into the communities they serve.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR ITEMS

Michael Machen, Deputy 911 Director/Emergency Manager, reported that with the recent storm, the 911 tower and building was struck by lightning. So even though some equipment had to be fixed, the backup system worked great. Mr. Machen participated in an active shooter exercise in Leelanau County. Mr. Machin highly recommends a training like this. Mr. Machen also took place in a tabletop exercise at the casino. Both events were good learning experiences.

9-1-1 DIRECTOR ITEMS

Complaints and traffic stops were up from last year. Two (2) Dispatchers were lost in July. Both positions have been filled. 9-1-1 is fully staffed but training continues.

JAIL ADMINISTRATOR ITEMS

Jail population has been averaging approximately 30 persons. Training three (3) new Correction Officers (CO's).

OTHER ITEMS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Commissioner Batzer and Commissioner Jaquish both thanked everyone for their teamwork and solution orientated approach. Thank you to the News Advocate for their coverage.

The meeting was adjourned at the Call of the Chair at 2:52 p.m.
