**PUBLIC COMMENT**

None.

**SHERIFF'S OFFICE ITEMS**

Undersheriff Jason Torrey presented the statistics for the month of August 2023  
(Appendix A) and September 2023 (APPENDIX B). The school resource officer has

started back in schools. Road patrol hours are down due to the deputy being back in the schools. Interviews were held yesterday for both road patrol and jail positions.

Sheriff Gutowski informed the committee they are still hiring. Deputy Rosa is in the academy in Traverse City. Considering two additional candidates for sponsorship with the academy. The body scanner is installed and staff training is done. They are currently working on a policy is still in progress.

Alex Schajter was promoted to Sergeant. Sheriff Gutowski spoke with MMR representative prior to the meeting. There are concerns with Munson Manistee not having patient care and all patients needing to be transferred and what that means for ambulance availability.

## **CITY OF MANISTEE PUBLIC SAFETY ITEMS**

### **CITY POLICE ITEMS**

Detective Sergeant Goodspeed reported for the City Police. Just as the Sheriff reported they continue to struggle with staffing. They currently have one sponsored recruit in the academy, with one to two possible to enroll in the future. The department is down three out of thirteen staff at currently. The summer was very busy but there seems to be a downtrend with complaints currently. Sleighbell preparations are underway.

The City Police Department is working on becoming accredited through the Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police and is set for the end of November. The department is allocating as many resources as possible to drug enforcement. They want to thank all partners in their assistance with this ongoing problem in the community.

### **CITY FIRE ITEMS**

Chief Tom Herndon informed the committee that the department has answered 1,900 calls as of October 1, 2023. Chief Herndon has been tracking mutual aid responses and they currently have had 138 mutual aid calls this year. One new fire staff is just finishing training and will be full-time next week. Another new hire starts later this month and the department will be at full staff.

## **MICHIGAN STATE POLICE REPORT**

Trooper Travis House Commander Cadillac Post presented for the Michigan State Police. James Grady was appointed this week as the new director of the Michigan State Police. The Cadillac Post just received a couple of transfers for staff, a trooper and K9 unit. By the end of October, they are looking to have 4 to 5 more troops on the road. The post covered approximately 100 complaints for Manistee County for September 2023.

## **TRIBAL POLICE ITEMS**

## **MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE (MMR)**

Danny Mosholder addressed statistics for the month of September 2023. (Appendix C) The department has had a lot of high priority calls in the last couple of weeks. They are still in need of paramedics. They are looking to host another EMT academy for the Manistee County area next year. A new ambulance went into service on Tuesday.

Munson Manistee Hospital ER will only have a physician during the day and overnights the ER will have an NP on staff, effective November 1, 2023. There will no longer be admissions for inpatient care. Any need for inpatient care will require patients to be transferred to Traverse City or Cadillac. Currently MMR only will do one non-STAT transfer at a time and keep a unit in Manistee for use. MMR is meeting with Munson Healthcare next week to receive more details going forward. Discussion followed.

## **JAIL ADMINISTRATOR ITEMS**

Lt. Chris Banicki presented the jail statistics for the month of August/September 2023. (Appendix D) They are working on getting a MAT Program provider in the jail. The mobile MAT program started four weeks ago using mobile MAT and have been busy. Lt. Banicki acknowledged the work being done in the jail. There were two overdoses in the last month, the staff is doing great work and caught a large amount of fentanyl. The body scanner will assist greatly in catching drugs coming into the jail.

## **9-1-1 DIRECTOR ITEMS**

Mike Machen, 911 Director presented the statistics for 911. (Appendix E) They are seeing a down trend in complaints. They hired two people, one started last week, one starts next week and are still down one staff member. Mike met with Portage Lake Association, along with Dr. McComb, in Onkama informational meeting regarding strokes and choking and things such as that. The hope was to get people interested in taking CPR courses. The department has completed getting MSP on the CAD system to see where units are and are working with DNR to get them on the system as well.

### EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR ITEMS


Alvin Rischel addressed the committee. September was an uneventful month for the department. They have received responses from all schools in the county and schedules for fire drills, tornado drills and lock down drills have been set. The department is looking to change from summer emergency events to inclement weather events for winter months and planning for possible events. The Department has been reviewing the County Emergency Action Plan and is in process of updating the plan.

### UNITED STATES COAST GUARD ITEMS


