**PUBLIC COMMENT**

None.

**SHERIFF'S OFFICE ITEMS**

Undersheriff Torrey presented the statistics for the month of October 2023 (Appendix A) Lisa Sagala informed the Sheriff that the training budget will be increasing due to State revenue sharing dedicating 2%, of the amount that the County, to go to public safety.

The department is currently down three deputies on the road. Deputy Rosa is currently in the academy in Traverse City. Sheriff Gutowski is looking to send two more to the academy at WSCC utilizing funds from the State of Michigan. Discussion followed.

Sheriff Gutowski attended the Michigan Sheriff's Association (MSA) in Lansing with Undersheriff. The new Tahoe is in service. At MSA, the sheriff was informed that supply for the Chevrolet Tahoe is severely lacking. Berger Chevrolet may not be able to fulfill orders. Sheriff Gutowski is looking at the Chevy Silverado to fulfill orders.

## **CITY OF MANISTEE PUBLIC SAFETY ITEMS**

### **CITY POLICE ITEMS**

Chief Josh Glass reported for the City Police. The department is currently down three officers. The city also has one officer in the academy and are looking to send two more. They received their Tahoe patrol vehicle finally. They are looking at new strategies to obtain new vehicles for their fleet.

There were no significant calls for Halloween, even with the notable increase in kids out trick or treating. Department focus is on sleighbell, they are very fortunate to have all law enforcement agencies assisting. The US31 bridge is to be open the week of sleighbell festival.

Chief Glass thanked all local partners for their assistance in combating drug matters in Manistee. Even being short-staffed and with staff working overtime there has been some significant progress made in combating drug matters in Manistee.

### **CITY FIRE ITEMS**

Chief Tom Herndon reported for the City Fire Department. They have handled over 839 EMS calls and mutual-aid calls are up 142 times this year. The department is currently at full staff, they recently started two new firefighters earlier this month, one is taking paramedic exam today.

Received local revenue sharing grant and will be purchasing equipment with those funds. Chief Herndon had a meeting with hospital, MMR and the city manager regarding transfers with changes at hospital. If the City were to assist with transfers it would decrease services in the City. They are trying to be proactive regarding the changes at the hospital. City Fire/EMS only do transports to ER and not to out county hospitals. Discussion Followed.

## **MICHIGAN STATE POLICE REPORT**

Lt. Travis House, Cadillac Post, reported for the Michigan State Police. Their staffing is trending upwards. They received trooper transfers in and a K9 unit. They are at the bare minimum in regards to staffing. They have a couple recruits coming out of trooper school in November. They are working with City of sleighbell and will provide staff for that. Also assisting on the road, when possible, to assist the Sheriff.

## **TRIBAL POLICE ITEMS**

Robert Medacco reported for the Little River Band Public Safety. Two sergeants are participating in a 5 month training for supervisory school. The recently purchased and received 2 drones, one for search and rescue and a tactical drone for in buildings and restricted areas, if need be. They will have four pilots. Two have licenses already and two are working on training. They are hoping to have everything implemented by the first of year. Purchased new body cameras and car cameras. Director Medacco had honor of awarding two life saving awards. One to Jeff Pefley and the other to Kyle Gunderson.

## **MOBILE MEDICAL RESPONSE (MMR)**

Danny Mosholder addressed statistics for the month of October 2023. (Appendix B) Numbers are a bit down from September. There were 643 transfers out of Manistee Hospital as of October 25, 2023. The EMT academy will be held March 25, 2024 in Manistee County. The new Munson Manistee physician group started November 1, 2023. Currently there is one ER doctor on 24/7, eventually at night will go down to an NP.

## **JAIL ADMINISTRATOR ITEMS**

Sheriff Gutowski presented the jail statistics for the month of October 2023. (Appendix C) Hiring continues to be a struggle in the jail. Work in the MAT program continues. The ATS Mobile MAT trailer continues in the parking lot at the jail.

## **9-1-1 DIRECTOR ITEMS**

Alvin Rischel, 911 Deputy Director presented the statistics for 911. (Appendix D) Starting the new fiscal year, they have started new projects within the department. The 800-radio upgrade for Fire EMS side is a focus for the department. They sent out to all fire departments inquiring how many mobile radios they will need to get cost for implementation. The 911 board approved and they will be moving over to 800 radio.

Close to full staff. New dispatcher started last month. Only have one training officer right now, so can only train one person at a time.

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR ITEMS**

Alvin Rischel addressed the committee. Chief Glass invited him to tabletop exercise at Manistee High School. He participated in three different scenarios with staff at MAPS. He was invited to attend WCSS safety team meeting. The department is looking to implement safety procedures at WCSS center downtown.

LATPA Region 7, has grant money that needs to be spent by May. Looking to purchase some forceable entry kits for law enforcement. They can only spend money for the region not the county. The region determines where to put the kits.


