Bear Lake Schools  
Bond Proposal

Shall Bear Lake Schools, Manistee County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Six Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$6,540,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping an addition to the school building; remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing and equipping and re-equipping the school building; erecting, furnishing and equipping an athletic structure; purchasing school buses; and developing, improving and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and the site?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2024 is 1.00 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 0 mill net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.65 mills (\$2.65 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
